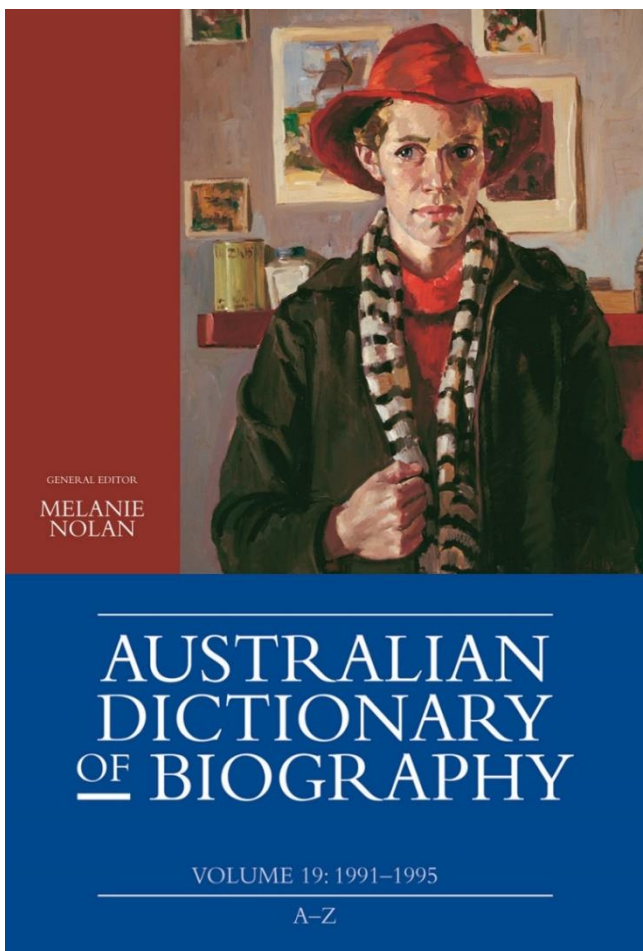


BOOK LAUNCH: Australian Dictionary of Biography, Volume 19

Volume 19 of the *Australian Dictionary of Biography* (ADB) contains 680 concise biographies of individuals who died between 1991 and 1995. The first of two volumes for the 1990s, it presents a colourful montage of late twentieth-century Australian life, containing the biographies of significant and representative Australians. The volume is still in the shadow of World War II with servicemen and women who enlisted young appearing, but these influences are dimming and there are now increasing numbers of non-white, non-male, non-privileged and non-straight subjects among lives of significant and representative Australians recorded in volume 19 of the ADB.
