Australian author and historian Cassandra Pybus will discuss her soon-to-be published book *Truganini: Journey Through the Apocalypse*.

The Indigenous museum curator, Gaye Sculthorpe, has described the book as giving this much misunderstood and misrepresented figure 'the proper attention she deserves.' For nearly seven decades, Truganini lived through a psychological and cultural shift more extreme than we can imagine. But her life was much more than a regrettable tragedy.
